In his declaration SUZUKI reported ownership of the vessel "Eburne". This vessel was sold through the Japanese Fishing Vessels Disposal Committee, and the net proceeds of \$1,084.00 were paid by the Committee to 1.Summi on June 9, 1942. Itaro SUZUKI declared \$50.00 in Victory Bonds. This was not brought nder the control of the Custedian. The account of this man was credited with \$160.00 from the sale of two nets, but as he did not declare ownership of any nets, and on Hovember 14, 1946, he wrote inferring that he had no interest in any rty that the Custodian might have sold, we are transferring this sum to Net Suspense Account. The account of this man was credited with the sum of \$2.68 as refund of security deposit for light received from the B. C. Electric Bailway. This money is being remitted to Itaro SUZUKI.
