

PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

November 26, 1946.

Re: Itaro SUZUKI, Reg. No. 03013

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 3, 1942. He was evacuated on September 17, 1942.

In his declaration SUZUKI reported ownership of the vessel "Eburne". This vessel was sold through the Japanese Fishing Vessels Disposal Committee, and the net proceeds of \$1,084.00 were paid by the Committee to I. Suzuki on June 9, 1942.

Itaro SUZUKI declared \$50.00 in Victory Bonds. This was not brought under the control of the Custodian.

The account of this man was credited with \$160.00 from the sale of two nets, but as he did not declare ownership of any nets, and on November 14, 1946, he wrote inferring that he had no interest in any property that the Custodian might have sold, we are transferring this sum to Net Suspense Account.

The account of this man was credited with the sum of \$2.68 as refund of security deposit for light received from the B. C. Electric Railway. This money is being remitted to Itaro SUZUKI.

This file reveals no other property of any kind.

This summary is certified to be in accordance with information on file.

This money was received from B. C. Packers Ltd. in payment of these nets, which were reported to be owned by "I. SUZUKI", and which had been stored at Terra Nova Cannery.

However, Itaro SUZUKI declared no nets. We wrote him on October 24th, this year, and informed him that we were trying to find a SUSUKI, whose property had been sold. We asked him if to inform us of any articles of any kind left by him in Eburne. He replied:

"I wish to acknowledge receipt of your letter of October 24th, giving me details of information on articles sold by you that belong to SUZUKI. I believe the articles are the property of my brother Sukesaburo Suzuki who is at present at Nays Hostel. Would you kindly contact him there. Meantime I shall inform him of the contents of your letter."

As there do not appear to be any missing nets, answering to the above description, on the file of Sukesaburo SUZUKI, File 7285, brother of Itaro, we have not written to him.

It is possible that the owner may be some other "I. SUZUKI" or perhaps "T. SUZUKI" or "J. SUZUKI". Until the owner can be identified the funds should remain in Net Suspense.

Dear Sir:

In your declaration to the Custodian on April 3, 1942, you reported ownership of a vessel and a \$50.00 Victory Bond.

According to information supplied to this office the vessel "Eburne" was sold by you through the Japanese Fishing Vessels Disposal Committee for the net sum of \$1,084.00, and this money was paid to you on June 9, 1942.

The Victory Bond was not under the control of the Custodian and we assume has been taken care of by yourself.

Some goods, said to belong to a man named "SUZUKI" have been sold by the Custodian. It is possible that the items sold are your property. If you left any articles of any kind in Eburne that have not been sold by you or otherwise disposed of by yourself, would you kindly let us know. Give us a description of the articles and tell us where these were left. If the money we are holding belongs to you it will be sent to you.

The sum of \$2.68 was received from the British Columbia Electric Railway as refund of security deposit for light. This has been credited to your account and will be sent to you when we have had a reply to this letter.
