PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY May 11, 1946. File No. 1430 Re: Takeo YOSHIDA, Registration No. 12156 This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on March 24, 1942. He was evacuated on May 28, 1942. In his declaration he reported ownership of a house valued at \$1,000.00 built on land of Stanley Littleton, Ucluelet. This is one of the houses built on land owned by the Lyche Estate and to date no settlement has been received. In an effort to reach a settlement we had this house appraised and the appraisal fee of \$15.00 has been charged against this account. In his declaration he reported a bed and kitchen utensils left in his house at Ucluelet. These were inventoried by H. G. Hinton and removed to storage at Fraser's Bay. The bed was sold at auction and the sum of \$3.05 was credited to this man's account. The kitchen utensials are unaccounted for but as Mr. Hinton stated in his report that they were of no value we assume that they have been discarded. He reported a bank account with the Royal Bank of Canada, Vancouver. This did not come under the control of this office. The records of the Japanese Fishing Vessels Disposl Committee show that this man was the owner of a boat "Red Wing", which was sold for the total sum of \$3,550.00. Supervision charges of \$40.50 were deducted and a claim for \$21.25 made by the Ucluelet Engineering Co. was satisfied, and on December 2, 1942 the amount of \$3,488.25 was remitted to YOSHIDA. The account of this man was credited with the sum of \$12.25 in settlement of claim filed with the Japanese Fishing Vessels Disposal Committee for refund of expenses incurred at the time of the impounding of the vessel "Red Wing". This file reveals no other property of any kind. This summary is certified to be in accordance with information on file. Brachaan May 11, 1946.

In eccordance with your instructions I have investigated and taken control of the property recorded on the above sen a registration form as follows:

BOOL PROMERTY

"House valued at \$1,000,00 was built on the land of Stenley Littleton, Ucluelet, B.C."

BOLEON STRUCTURE

"Has one bed and kitchen uteneils left in house at Veluelet, B.C."

in connection therewith I have to report as follows:

Location:

This is a small Japanese settlement on the foreshore of Beluelet Dulet about half a mile from the public where on Lend Land leased from the Lyone Estate.

ROLL Property:

The declarant's valuation of this house is too high. It is a treme shingle roof four-room bungelow 24' x 24', with Lean-to kitchen 8' x 8', with front and besk porch and outside privy. There is no water laid on. The estimated realizable relue is ebout \$500.00.

Personal Property:

The items mentioned were found in the house, They have no resizeable value except as sorap.

Insurance:

As this house is part of a settlement of houses built in alose proximity to each other, no insurance can be effected.

Lieblittles:

None are recorded, but I is informed that the declarent owes the sum of \$51.25 to the Ucluslet Engineering Works.

Recommendations:

I am informed by Mr. Littleton, the appointed agent for the Japanese, that the ground rentals, due to the Lyche Estate from the owners of the buildings in this settlement, have been paid to June 1942, and that the Lyche Estate will be agreeable to permitting the Japanese to re-occupy the buildings should they be permitted to return. I have not been able to ascertain definitely from Mr. Littleton or his solicitors-Mr. A. G. McCuiloch, Port Alberni, B.C.--what rent was paid by the Japanese, but understand that there was no written agreement.

I recommend that Mr. Littleton be saked to state definitely what he considers the exect position to be. Mr. Littleton stated that if the house is rented he will retain helf the rent to apply on the lease, and remit the other half to the Japanese owner.

I further recommend that Mr. Littleton be instructed to remit the rents (if any) to the Custodian's office.

REPORT

ret Japanese Property - Disposal of Ucluelet and Tofino.

UCLUELRY

Leaches Bay - Lot 262 (property adjacent to Airbase); the following houses are situated on the property of the Lyche Estate, controlled by S. S. Littleton, Ucluelet. Littleton states that 25 years ago when the Japanese first moved on to the Lyche property, a lease was sade whereby the Japanese would be allowed to build houses on the property, but if wacated the houses would revert to the owner of the property, however, Br. Littleton could not show any lease to this effect hor could any of the Japanese. The Japanese have been jaying the sum of \$350. (total) rent per year to the Lyche estate. Littleton also stated that he is ging to rent these houses and forward half the rent to the Japanese, and allow them to have back after the duration.

One half of these houses are situated over tidal waters. Only seven of the total 19 houses habitable, the other 12 being more shacks, however, I believe they will all eventually be accupied by RGLF personal due to the accute housing problem here.

The Japanese School house, comparatively new, and the school teacher's house adjining are the sest valuable buildings.

The following valuations were given to the undersigned by the Japanese but with the exception of seven of the houses the value appears to be practically nil:

We understants that it is a temporary measure, a step taken on my advice until the proper authorities organized a process of caring for this property. The present arrangement is that he will look ofter the welfare of these houses, Collect and forward reutal sonies and receive 15% Commission.

4. In addition to the above centioned property there are six boat floats which average of the value of \$500. at the different bays.
