

Geo. Peters, formerly of Gatdn office, placed an abandonment notice on file re one iron and one wooden bed. This is unsigned and undated (PP.8), and Peters is in Galifornia.

e) Screen doors & Grock \$7,00 No record of same at this Office.

Presumably Screen Doors were left attached to Cannery house where Claim and resided, and as not declared, not considered by Catdn removal agent as his personal property.

Huckvale has included on Eth.4 "Kitchen Utensils" to a value of \$69.00 The original Glaim was as follows:-

"Kitch, utensils:-

Platters, dishes, cups 37.00
SGREEN DOOR & GROCK 7.00
Trays 10.00
