GENERAL MEMORANDUM

November 9, 1945

This person, who was evacuated on September 5, 1942, signed a declaration to the Custodian on March 30, 1945, stating that she owned no property of any kind in the protected area.

The camera, described on Specified Articles Memorandum, was reported to this office by the Royal Canadian Mounted Police. This was proved to be the property of Shizuyo MAIKAWA by the receipt which she sent to this office, and the camera has been mailed to her.

The file reveals no liabilities.

The file reveals no evidence of any other property of any kind belonging to this person.


