This file reveals the above owned no real property in any protected area of B.C., and did not carry any Fire Insurance.

CHATELS:

The above, who made his declaration to the Custodian on April 3/42 and was evacuated on May 28/42, declared one row boat, 1 Cohoe fishing net - 300 fathoms, at Wales Island Cannery, Naas River, B.C., and household effects as noted on the J.P. form, at 54 Chatham St., Steveston, a house owned by the Canadian Fishing Company. On Oct. 22/42 the Canadian Fishing Co. Ltd. wrote us enclosing a statement of account covering equipment which was left by the above at their Wales Island Cannery, together with a cheque in the sum of \$25.69 in full settlement. This sum was credited to the account of the above with this office.

No chattels were found at any time by the Custodian agent in Steveston belonging to the above, nor has he ever written about his effects, so we assume he made his own arrangements about disposing of them before his evacuation or else took them with him.

SPECIFIED ARTICLES:

According to information supplied to this office the above was the registered owner of a fishing vessel the "I.N." which was sold through the Japanese Fishing Vessel Disposal Committee for the net sum of \$693.00. The above owed the purchaser of this vessel the sum of \$300.00 which was deducted from the sales price, and the balance in the sum of \$393.00 was paid to the above on March 24/42. Full details are given on the Specified Articles Summary on file.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.


