We are in receipt of the "JP" Form
for this Japanese. He is, of course, evacuated.
The property which is a very dilapidated two story
house, is occupied by some foreigners now and they
advised us that the Japanese sold this place to
Lal Singh, an East Indian who lives at Fort Langley,
B. C.

There is none of the personal property
which the Japanese declared, left in the house. There
are, however, three large packing boxes, one trunk and
a sack of rice in one of the rooms. The party in the
house mentioned that they expected the Japanese to
return for these a few days ago.

If there is anything further you wish
us to do in this connection, please advise us.

In answer to yours of the 4th, please be advised that I acknowledge this claim against me, and also acknowledge the fact that I did receive the sum of \$510.00 for the sale of land, but for the undermentioned reasons, cannot see my way clear to meet this claim.

From the money received for the sale of the land, I had to pay taxes for two and one-half years, which had become delinquent and water for the similar period. This took a great portion of the money. Then on June 3, 1942, due to the fact that New Westminster had become a "Restricted Area", I was forced to move to Vancouver to live, for five months, until October 4, 1942, when I was evacuated to my present location. As, my husband had left for road camp early in March, and had left me without funds, the balance of the money was used by me, for the maintenance of my family, during my stay in Vancouver.

I regret exceedingly that I cannot pay this claim, under the present circumstances, and thank you for the inconvenience caused you.
