Mrs. Kuwata has asked me to write you concerning
your letter to her of the 9th instant.

She acknowledges that the items #2 Dr. J. C. Foote
\$13.00 and #3 M. Furaya Co. \$10.78, are owing by her, but feels
that she should not be expected to pay the item of \$3.00 (#1)
owing Dr. J. D. Stenstrom.

This latter item, evidently covers a house visit
that was made to see the granddaughter of Mrs. Kuwata, and at the
same time the Dr. arranged for Mrs. Kuwata to call at his office
with regard to her arm. However, Mrs. Kuwata's daughter, the
mother of the child in question, paid \$2.50 to the doctor while
he was at the house for the visit to see the child, although she
did not receive a receipt. Mrs. Kuwata did not go to the Dr.'s
office, and felt therefore that she should not have to pay this
\$3.00.
