

GENERAL SUMMARY

This 60-year old Farmer from Victoria, B. C., a Japanese National, signed a "No Property" card on March 30th, 1942.

He was evacuated on April 28th, 1942.

This widower declared 4 children to be living in Japan and 1 daughter (File 721) to be living with him.

The following is a summary of the contents of this file as disclosed by a review made today.

Real Property: None.

Chattels: This Evacuee declared no Chattels but permission was asked for, and given (Mar. 9/44) to Mr. R. H. Holt, Victoria, to ship a garden hose, several packets of garden seeds and a bottle of Japanese sauce direct to him.

Accounts Receivable: None.

Bonds, Shares, etc.: None.

Bank Accounts: None.

Life Insurance: None.

Liabilities: A claim of \$48.73 registered (Dec. 14/43) by Scott & Peden Ltd., Victoria, against "Nagai, Cordova Bay, B. R. #4, Victoria, B. C." was referred to this Evacuee on Feb. 22/43, Dec. 12/43 and Mar. 2/44, to which letters he never replied.

Funds: The Custodian holds no funds for this Evacuee.
