When my family were required to leave Victoria, B.C., under the evacuation orders, they gave up, among other things, a well-kept 1936-7 RCA cabinet radio. This radio was purchased by me from the Kent Music Store, Yates Street, Victoria, B. C., a number of years ago.

Upon inquiry here, I was directed to get in touch with your office in order to ascertain if the radio is still being held by you or if it has been sold. No doubt you receive numerous such requests, but I would appreciate it greatly if you would be good enough to let me know the 'fate' of our radio: I had hoped to have it sent east.

Dear Madam:

Your daughter, Miss Marion Yoneda, has written to this office inquiring about an R.C.A. cabinet radio. This radio, we believe, is the one turned in to the police by you.

If it is satisfactory to you to have this radio shipped to your daughter, you could arrange with the British Columbia Security Commission for shipment. It cannot be shipped to your daughter without your permission.

In the case of shipment to your daughter, packing and shipping charges would be paid by your daughter or yourself.

The radio will not be sold for the present to give you time to arrange for shipment.

Dear Sir,

I am in receipt of your letter dated April 12, in which you made reference to an R.C.A. cabinet radio.

This radio, along with the others from Japanese homes in Victoria, was taken by the R.C. M. P. in that city, prior to our evacuation to Hastings Park. Ever since that time we have had no word concerning it.

As my daughter Marion has made no mention of this matter in recent letters, I have written to her asking her about it. Therefore, I would appreciate it a great deal if you would kindly hold same until I hear from her.

Could you kindly let me know where these radios are now? Also, an approximate amount for packing and shipping charges. If this radio is still in the R.C. M. P. office in Victoria that would mean that it would be packed and shipped from that city.

would it not? I am anxious to be
cleared on that matter.

On the other hand, if the radios are
sold, what are the procedures
your department follows?

I shall greatly appreciate
any information concerning
this matter.
