The net proceeds of the sale of the radio surrendered by Mr. Onishi amounts to \$28.79.

The sum of \$33.75 represents interest on \$200.00 Victory Bonds belonging to Mrs. Onishi. A total of \$34.50 was credited to your account from this source, but the fee charged by the bank for transferring the four Bonds to Toronto was 75 cents, and this charge was paid from the funds in the account.
