GENERAL SUMMARY

This 59-year old Barber from Victoria, B. C., a Japanese National, signed a "No Property" card on March 30th, 1942.

This Widower declared his daughter (File 1681) to be residing with him.

He was evacuated on September 22nd, 1942.

The following is a summary of the contents of this file as disclosed by a review made today.


