

This woman signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 7, 1942. She was evacuated on September 8, 1942.

In her declaration she reported 17 pieces of effects left at Powell Lake, B.C. On June 29, 1942 and July 6, 1942 she requested shipment of 4 of these pieces and 6 more pieces, leaving 13 pieces unaccounted for, as shown on Chattel Schedule.

This file reveals no other property of any kind.


Please note that the above Japanese has been repatriated to Japan. The following is the status of his account with this Department, covering the repatriation transactions:
