CHATELS: The above, who made his declaration to the Custodian on April 7/42 and was evacuated on Oct. 13/42, declared the following:

All left in the house at 3752 E. Hastings St., Vancouver. An inventory of goods belonging to the above was sent to us by our agent Mr. H. D. Campbell, which was the same as the above declared with the addition of 1 wooden counter and 2 clothes racks with drawers. Our agent, Mr. Campbell, further reported on Oct. 15/42 that the above was reported to have taken his sewing machine and heater with him when he was evacuated, together with bedding and usual personal belongings, and that he had disposed of a few sundry pieces of equipment. We wrote to KONDO on Oct. 20/42 for confirmation of this, but received no reply.

The file reveals that the above owned no specified articles.

WAR SAVINGS CERTIFICATES: The above declared 5 \$5.00 War Savings Certificates left in his house at 3752 E. Hastings St. These did not come under the control of the Custodian.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.

The above summary is certified to be in accordance with the information on file.

2. The premises occupied at the above address consist of the ground floor with a store in front and three living rooms in the rear, which are occupied by Kondo, his wife and three children.


3. The property is rented at \$17.00 per month. The rent for April, due the First of this month, has not been paid in full, there being \$7.00 still owing.

4. The list of equipment, fixtures and personal effects included in the Declaration is correct in all respects with the exception that a wooden counter and two clothes racks with drawers were not included. An inventory is attached herewith.

5. Apparently Kondo has not as yet received any instructions with regard to evacuation and intends to continue operating the business in conjunction with his wife, until such time as he receives specific instructions from the Commission.

I have instructed him to advise me if, as and when he receives such instructions and keep me posted in regard to his plans for the disposal of his effects.

6. Supplementary reports will be forwarded to you as Mr. Kondo's situation develops.

Re- KONDO, Katsujiro

Since last April I have been making routine checks with this Japanese with regard to his evacuation. During the course of these contacts he had been warned to advise me of any intended disposal of his chattels.

It has been necessary to make contact with this man by calls as he has no telephone and on my representative calling at his place of business on October 13, he found that Mr. Kondo had been evacuated to Tashme that morning and the premises empty.

Mr. Kidd, the Rental Agent, whose office is almost adjoining these premises, was contacted and provided the information that the rent was paid to date and the light and gas disconnected and paid for. He also volunteered the information that Kondo had taken his sewing machine and heater with him, together with bedding and usual personal belongings and had disposed of a few sundry pieces of equipment.

From information provided by Mr. Kidd, this man was well known in the small community at the corner of Boundry Road and East Hastings, and dealt entirely in cash and had no creditors.

It would therefore appear that the matter of his disposing of the few possessions, which could not realize more than \$35.00 to \$50.00, is of no moment and I believe this file can be satisfactorily closed.
