We have for acknowledgment your letter of April 16th inquiring about a Japanese named Shoraku Oyeda. This man is unknown to us and it occurs to us that it may be intended for S. Uyeda. We understand he is a fairly young man and lives with his father in a house on our property at the foot of Blenheim Street.

The location as given by you, namely, 49th and Blenheim is incorrect, but on talking with the manager at our plant, which is located at the foot of Blenheim Street, he states that the post office mail box is located at about 49th and Blenheim and that the Japanese may have presumed, in the absence of any specific street number, that this was a fair way of describing how he might be located.

If you refer to S. Uyeda, we understand the house is still occupied by his father and other members of the family. There is no definite rental paid for the house and he was allowed occupancy solely on account of his having been one of our fishermen.
