


Please note that the above has been repatriated to Japan. At the time of repatriation, the following transactions took place:


Mrs. Haruko KAWAGUCHI, Reg. No. 12098

This woman in her declaration to the Custodian, April 7, 1942, declared 16 items of household and personal effects left in the store house at Port Alberni in charge of the Police. Of these items 12 were shipped to her in May, 1942. The 4 remaining articles were 2 beds and 2 springs. These were sold at Port Alberni auction No. 1 January 12, 1942. In addition to the articles declared, a bedstead identified as the property of KAWAGUCHI was sold at Port Alberni Auction No. 1. As this is the only person of that name from the Port Alberni district who declared any furniture, this bedstead has been credited to her account. The net proceeds from the Auction Sale were \$27.31 which were credited to the account of Haruko KAWAGUCHI.

She also declared \$25.00 in War Savings Certificates in her own possession. These did not come under the control of this office.

No other property is revealed by this file.

Dear Sir and Madam:

This is to inform you that a Credit Balance of \$27.31 is standing in your account with this office. These funds were derived from the sale of chattels identified as your property, which were sold at Auction at Port Alenah. According to our records all the rest of the household and personal effects declared by Mrs. KAWAGUCHI, were shipped to her in 1942.

The \$25.00 worth of War Savings Certificates which you declared, did not come under the control of this office.

The Union Fish Co. Ltd. have filed a claim against you for the sum of \$32.35. Would you kindly let us know if you wish to have the \$27.31 which is standing to your credit with this office, applied against this liability.

It would appear that we have accounted for all the property of every kind left by you in the protected area which vested in the Custodian and in order that you may confirm this and let us know about the Union Fish Co. Ltd.'s claim, we enclose a stamped, addressed envelope for your convenience in replying.
