Dear Sirs:

Following is an extract from a letter received from Mrs. Ted Sakamoto, Slocan Extension, B.C. Her radio is in my custody and I 'phoned your office yesterday to inquire whether I could forward the radio to her, if what she says in her letter is right. Your office is going to contact Ottawa in this connection and let me know their ruling.

"I have decided since it is impossible to have it sent, to let my guardians have it. I would have taken it to them if I had been in Vancouver at the time of confiscation. Since it is rather hard for me to write to you, being a stranger, would you please send it to Rev. William Deans, 275 E. 23rd. Avenue Vancouver, or have it at your place of business and 'phone him to call for it. Phone no. is Fairmont 0132.

"It is a puzzle to a lot of us, why I cannot have something which is mine, paid for and legally allowed here, to be sent to me. A longwave radio of such a size which never could be misused. If we order from mail-order houses we can get it but I feel even \$25.00 or \$30.00 is more than we can afford when we are earning so little."
