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
Please note that the above has been repatriated to Japan. At the time of repatriation, the following transactions took place:

PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

May 23, 1946.

Re: Takino KINGSHITA, Reg. No. 10905

This woman signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 7, 1942. She was evacuated on September 24, 1942.

In her declaration she reported a basket trunk of clothing at Hastings Park, in her own possession. We assume these were taken with her on her evacuation.

On May 20, 1942, she requested 2 trunks and 5 boxes from Wes Brown at O'Brian Bay, B.C. These were taken delivery of by Mr. Saunders at Hastings Park on instructions from this office.

She reported a bank account with a balance of \$300.00 with the Royal Bank of Canada, Vancouver. This did not come under the control of this office.
