



CHATELS: The above registered April 8, 1942 and was evacuated August 4, 1942. He declared a sewing machine, household effects and kitchen utensils at 432 West 2nd Ave., but stated that when he left he would leave them with his brother-in-law S. Fukumaga, 726 East Cordova St. Our representatives did not find his chattels at this address and he was so advised on October 20, 1942. He replied that he had sold his chattels prior to evacuation.

SPECIFIED
ARTICLES:

The Japanese Fishing Vessel Disposal Committee shows he was the owner of the fishing vessel "Lions Gate" which was sold by them for \$12,500.00 which, after deducting charges against the vessel, resulted in the net amount of \$9,640.08 being paid to KOJIMA on March 26, 1942.

SHARES:

Extract dated June 12, 1944 states that he owned 10 shares in the B. C. Purchasers Association.

His address was given to the parties concerned so that they could follow up the collections if desired.
