

CHATELS:

Mr. MAYEDA declared that his effects were left at 166, 5th Avenue, Vancouver, B. C. but, were sold or taken away by him as per his signed statement of May 15th, 1942. He declared that a quantity of books, dolls, beds, tools and one case of silver & glass were stored at 335 (339) Ewen Avenue, New Westminster in care of E. ONISHI, File 7716. Some of these goods were shipped to him on May 8th, 1944 but several boxes of effects were not found at that place when the Custodian removed ONISHI'S effects to auction. A full explanation is given on the Chattel Summary.

SPECIFIED
ARTICLES:

His Sparton Consol P. B. radio was returned to the Custodian by the R. C. M. P. and was sold at auction realizing the net sum of \$37.73 which was placed to his credit.

His Eastman Vest Pocket Kodak camera was mailed to him on February 2nd, 1946.

MAYEDA declared a \$50.00 Victory Bond in his own possession. This did not come under the control of the Custodian.



CHATEL SUMMARY

Re: Tsukane MAYEDA, Reg. 03202

The above Japanese made his declaration to the Custodian on April 8th, 1942 and was evacuated on May 2nd, 1942.

He declared that certain goods were left at 166 W. 5th Avenue, Vancouver, B. C. In a statement dated May 15th, 1942 he stated however, that he had sold or taken away all the articles listed as being left at the foregoing address but that he had also stored other personal possessions in the house of E. ONISHI, File 7726, 335 Even St. (Avenue) New Westminster, B. C. These are listed on a separate sheet and consisted of 14 pieces of effects. They were not checked by the Custodian as Room 12, in which they were stored was padlocked and the key was not available.

A memo on MAYEDA'S list states that a request was received from Miss Tait (Welfare Worker) on July 22nd, 1943 for the release of his effects. It may be assumed that this refers to the release of some of Mr. MAYEDA'S stored effects as several boxes were not found.


Mrs. Kasuye MAYEDA (wife of Tsukane MAYEDA, file 8873) declared she had no effects whatsoever, but on January 12th, 1943, a shipment of 2 boxes of utensils is recorded as being made from 335 Even Avenue. The number of these do not tally with the list on Mr MAYEDA'S file.

On April 11th, 1944, Mr. MAYEDA requested the shipment of 4 cartons and boxes of books, 2 boxes of dolls and 3 bed frames. These were shipped by the B.C. Security Commission on May 8th, 1944. However, only 3 boxes of books were shipped as he had given the package number of these. 5 boxes books, 1 case silver & glassware (not inventoried) and 1 box carpenters tools were not found.

When removing ONISHI'S stored effects from 335 (339) Even Avenue (a rooming house) to our auction rooms in New Westminster, it was noted that Tom Butak, the lessee, had removed all Japanese effects from Room 12 into Room 14. The file does not reveal that the Custodian gave him the permission to do so.


