SHIKATANI admitted this claim in his letter of Jan. 27/44 and we paid same from funds standing to his credit on Feb. 2/45.

Acme Importers \$60.50

In his letter of June 19/45 SHIKATANI admits this debt and asks us to pay same from funds derived from sale of his boat. We have only \$49.94 left in his account from sale of his boat engine, so this sum will be sent to Acme Importers to make a part payment on this claim.

There are no claims on the file of his wife.
