A letter from Ker and Ker dated October 2, 1942 advises that they were collecting rent on the above property for Mr. KINOSHITA.

KINOSHITA advised on December 21, 1942 that the property did not belong to him but to his uncle KATO, Toyotaro, File 11862.

PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

Re: KINOSHITA, Raisuke - Reg. No. 02493.

The above signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 8, 1942 and was evacuated on July 17, 1942.

CHATELS: As will be seen from the Chattel Summary chattels at 566 East Cordova were sold by KINOSHITA. Later we were advised that they belonged to Toyotaro KATO, File 11862, and the proceeds were transferred to that account. Two shipments were made to KINOSHITA of goods left at 513 East Cordova St. It is possible that other goods belonging to KINOSHITA were left at that address. In any case there seems little that could be done now as all chattels moved from that address have been sold and credited to Gizo KONDO, former resident of 513 East Cordova.

18 Judo Mats found at 604 East Cordova were found to belong to KINOSHITA and proceeds of their sale transferred to his account.

SPECIFIED

ARTICLES:

Car: He declared a Buick Sedan valued at \$2,300.00 turned over to the R. C.M.P. This car, a 1934 Buick Sedan was appraised at \$300.00 and sold for \$275.00, less administration expenses of \$27.93, leaving a net \$247.77 credited to his account.

RADIO: He declared a Victor Radio valued at \$85.00. This was appraised at \$15.00, sold for \$19.00, less \$3.42 expenses, leaving a net of \$15.58.

It will be noted that KINOSHITA evidently greatly overvalued his car and radio.

BONDS:

He declared 2 War Savings Certificates at \$5.00 each in the name of Kitoko KINOSHITA and 1 War Savings Certificate at \$5.00 in the name of his son Junji KINOSHITA. These were in his own possession and were not brought under the control of the Custodian.

This file reveals no other property.

CHattel SUMMARYRe: KINOSHITA, Raisuke - Reg. No. 02493.

The above declared chattels left at 566 East Cordova which he stated he would move to 513 East Cordova. This was on April 8, 1942. A fairly large list of chattels then appears on the file. However this list is undated and does not give the exact location of the chattels listed. The list given in the J. P. Form was sent to the occupier of 566 East Cordova so that he could acknowledge holding the goods (17/4/42). The long list of chattels was also sent to the occupier on April 20, 1942. Neither were returned. On April 20, 1942 KINOSHITA wrote saying that he had left other goods previously not mentioned, at 566 East Cordova but had taken the sewing machine with him. Finally the chattels at 566 East Cordova were sold by KINOSHITA on May 18, 1942 at the suggestion of W. H. Gallagher, who were agents for the building and claiming rent from KINOSHITA. Their claim was satisfied and the residue forwarded by them to Ker and Ker who handled KINOSHITA's affairs. They in turn, after deducting their commission, shipment of records to KINOSHITA and the payment of Taxes on a property at Surrey, handled by KINOSHITA, for his father-in-law, Toyotaro KATO, remitted a balance of \$48.06. Later KINOSHITA advised the chattels belonged to his father-in-law and the balance was transferred to File 11862, KATO's File.

We were not provided with a list of what KINOSHITA left at 513 East Cordova. The building was owned by Otojiro KONDO, in Japan and was formerly the residence of his nephew Gizo KONDO, File 10468, who also left chattels at that address. Shipment of 4 boxes of kitchen utensils, glassware and chinaware, 1 box of pots and pans and 1 apple box full of school books, was made on December 17, 1943. A White Sewing Machine was also shipped on January 31, 1945. Both lots of goods came from 513 East Cordova St.

All the chattels left at 513 East Cordova were moved under the name of KONDO and sold by Auction, the proceeds being remitted to KONDO. KINOSHITA did not enquire about any chattels when we had correspondence with him regarding his sewing machine and it is possible that the boxes and the sewing machine constituted all his property.

In his letter of April 20, 1942 KINOSHITA mentioned 16 Japanese straw mattresses which he stated having left at 566 East Cordova. 18 Judo Mats found at 604 East Cordova, the Honpa Buddhist Temple and sold for the sum of \$18.00, we are told by Yoshikazu NISHIMURA, belong to KINOSHITA and have therefore been transferred to his account.


