PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

File No. 1847

RE: Jinichi KONO, Reg. No. 06957

CHATELS:

The above, who made his declaration to the Custodian on April 8/42 and was evacuated on May 23/42, declared the following:

1 gas fishing boat (Miss Canada) in custody of the Navy at Prince Rupert
2 nets marked with owner's name in Watermans Cannery at Rivers Inlet
Household and personal effects at 259 E. Hastings St., Vancouver.

In reply to a letter from us enquiring about his household and personal goods, the above replied on Oct. 10/42 stating that he had disposed of these goods prior to his evacuation.

The fishing nets were destroyed in a fire in the cannery at Rivers Inlet and the above was paid the sum of \$100.00 by the B.C. Packers to recompense him for his loss. This money was paid by the B.C. Packers into this office and was credited to the account of the above with us. On March 24/43 we received a letter from Swanson & Wilkinson, barrister advising us that they had in their care chattels belonging to the above which he had asked to have shipped to him on Custodian release dated March 5/43. These were shipped and a bill of lading for 45 cases was sent to Swanson & Wilkinson on April 14/43. The cartage and freight charges on these goods amounted to \$47.28 and this sum was deducted from the \$100.00 standing to the credit of the above with this office.

On May 13/43 Mr. V.M. Dafoe in a letter under that date, advised us that KONO had left a 5 H.P. Palmer engine at the Palmer shop to be repaired. (Mr. Dafoe is the B.C. representative of Palmer Bros.) Repairs were made to the engine, but repeated efforts to have KONO remove this engine and pay the bill were of no avail. The engine was therefore sold by Mr. Dafoe to cover the repair bill and storage charge. KONO was advised of this matter and also of outstanding debts filed against him in the sum of \$20.25 in our letter of May 17/43.

We have also been advised by Bowman Storage that KONO has a piano and a piano bench in storage in their warehouse and that up to April 15/46 outstanding storage charges in the sum of \$10.50 were due on these articles.

SPECIFIED ARTICLES:

The fishing vessel declared by the above was not in custody but was tied up at Wadham's Cannery, Rivers Inlet. The engine was the one we have mentioned above which was sold by Palmer Bros. to pay repair and storage charges and the hull of the boat was stated to be of no value. Full details are given on Specified Articles Summary on file.

VICTORY BOND:

The above declared a \$100.00 Victory Bond in his own possession. This did not come under the control of the Custodian.

BANK ACCOUNTS:

The above declared two bank accounts, one in the Bank of Montreal, Main and Hastings Sts. in the sum of \$80.00 and the other in the Japan and Canada Trust Co., Powell St., Vancouver, in the sum of \$120.00.

Neither of these accounts came under the control of the Custodian.

After paying the freight and cartage charges on goods shipped to KONO and an account of \$3.00 owing to Dr. UCHIDA by the above, there is now a balance of \$49.72 in his account, and this sum will be sent to him in the course of the next few days.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.
