This file reveals the above owned no real property in any protected area of B.C., and did not carry any Fire Insurance.

CHATELS:

The above, who made his declaration to the Custodian on April 28/42 and was evacuated on April 28/42, declared a few household effects as noted on the J.P. form, left in a Pacific Coast Cannery House.

Effects were found in House #11, Pacific Coast Cannery, marked with the name of the above and these were inventoried by Custodian agent, C.C. Robinson, on June 26/42, as per list #54 on file, and removed to central storage. These effects were sold at Steveston auction #40 for the net sum of \$10.50 and this sum credited to the account of the above with this office.

Some effects were found at Pacific Coast Cannery House #15 in the name of Mrs. Han HONDA, wife of the above. These were inventoried by Custodian agent, C.C. Robinson, as per List #82 on file of his wife, No. 5869. These were sold for the net sum of \$14.73 and this sum credited to the account of Mrs. Han HONDA.

The above requested on March 2/45, through the B.C.S.C., that all funds standing to the credit of himself and his wife be forwarded to him. The only funds at that date was a credit of \$6.56 in the account of his wife, but there were more goods to be sold and the above was advised of these facts in our letter of March 7/45. However he replied stating he wished a cheque for this sum so Custodian cheque was accordingly remitted to Mrs. HONDA on March 26/45 for \$6.56.

The file reveals the above owned no specified articles.

LIFE
INSURANCE:

The above declared an insurance policy with the Sun Life Assurance Company in the sum of \$1000.00, the beneficiary being his wife, Han. The cash surrender value of this policy in the sum of \$54.68 was received in this office and remitted to the above on Jan. 25/44.
