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GENERAL SUMMARY

File No. 1854

October 6, 1947

Re: Takeo NAKAHAMA, Reg. # 00760

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 8, 1942. The date of his evacuation is not shown in his file.

He stated in his declaration that he lived at 253 Powell with his parents. His parents stated that they lived at 250 Powell.

NAKAHAMA declared a 1938 Dodge Sedan valued at \$800.00, which was then in the custody of the RCMP. This vehicle was sold by the Custodian for the sum of \$553.00 on December 28, 1942. The car had been appraised at \$650.00. Expenses incurred in connection with this car were \$36.07, leaving a net sum of \$516.93, which was credited to the account of Takeo NAKAHAMA.

NAKAHAMA declared a General Electric Mantel Radio valued at \$40.00, which was at the time in the custody of the RCMP. There is no record of a radio having been surrendered by Takeo NAKAHAMA, but his sister-in-law, Mrs. Masaye NAKAHAMA, File 6042, did surrender a Westinghouse radio. We wrote NAKAHAMA, on January 10, 1945, informing him that we had no record of his radio, and asking for a copy of the receipt he had been given when he surrendered the radio, in order that we might try to trace his radio. He did not reply, so it would seem that he did not surrender a radio.

NAKAHAMA declared no other property, but on February 16, 1943, he inquired about Japanese self defence equipment; a mask, a hip protector, chest protector, pair of gloves and a bamboo sword, which he said were at 250 Powell. Nothing identified with the name of this man was found at 250 Powell, but some items which might have been part of the equipment referred to were sold after removal from those premises. Goods removed from 250 Powell in the name of NAKAHAMA and later sold have been credited to the account of Masaye NAKAHAMA, File 6042.

On May 22, 1944, Bowman Storage informed us that they had been requested to ship a cash register, adding machine and typewriter which this man had removed from 253 Powell and stored with his other goods in Bowman warehouse. We have no record of what other goods were stored at Bowman Storage for this man. We informed the storage company that it would be in order to ship the goods, and we assume that shipment was made.
