Re: P/W A-748, Yoshida, Hideo.

Further to our letter of the 2nd of March, we have now completed our investigation of the matter and regret to have to inform you that through an error in this office, the War Savings Certificates referred to in our letter of the 22nd of December were redeemed in favour of Hideo Yoshida, and the cheque mailed to Slocan, B.C. We enclose a photostat copy of the cheque, from which you will observe that it purports to have been negotiated by Yoshida and presented to us for payment through the Bank of Montreal. In view of your advices that Yoshida is interned, we presume that it would not have been possible for him to have negotiated the cheque, and consequently the endorsement on this item must be irregular. In the circumstances, we would ask you to kindly submit the photostat to Yoshida for examination and if our assumption is correct, please have him sign the enclosed Statutory Declaration which it will be necessary for us to have in order to support our claim for reimbursement from the Bank of Montreal.

Dear Sir:

At the time of internment the above internee had forwarded to Ottawa for surrender five War Savings Certificates, and subsequent to his internment a cheque was issued, dated November 17th, 1942, by the Receiver General of Canada in his favour for \$20.20.

Through an error in the office of the Registrar of War Savings Certificates, this cheque was mailed to the internee at Slocan, B.C. and the cheque was cashed through the Bank of Montreal at that point on December 19th, 1942. It would appear from this that some person forged the name of the internee on the cheque and cashed it.

Attached please find the necessary Declaration to be signed by the internee, so that recovery of the funds may be made from the Bank of Montreal and another cheque issued. Please have this Declaration signed properly, witnessed and the change of address at the top of the Declaration initialed by the witness. Before having the internee sign the enclosed declaration, will you kindly point out to him that it is possible that the Bank of Montreal will take the necessary steps to see that whoever committed the forgery is punished. Should he decide to approve of the endorsement on this cheque, please take a signed and written declaration to this effect.
