Dear Sir:

Upon enquiry to the Provincial Assessor, Vancouver, regarding the refund of \$4.80 Provincial Income Tax for 1941, I have been informed that the amount was remitted to you and that I should write to you for information as to what has become of it.

Kindly inform me what steps if any are necessary to claim the amount. I am a Canadian born of Naturalized Japanese parentage evacuated to Slocan from Vancouver last year and have now been transferred to Kaslo, B. C. My Japanese Registration Number is 04855. As I have reported to you on the proper forms prior to evacuation, in my knowledge I am indebted financially to no one and so believe I have the right to claim from your hands the above amount due me.

I have enquired previously and been told that I could as usual withdraw from my Savings Account at the Royal Bank of Canada, Vancouver, money for any payments by issuing a cheque. Kindly confirm this for I expect to do so for my Life Insurance Premium due next month payable to Crown Life Insurance Co.

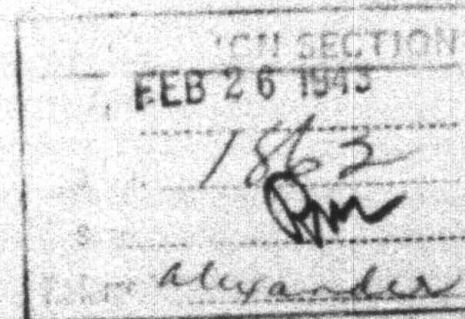

I am in receipt of your letters of the 18th and the 20th with the cheque for \$4.80, being the refund of 1% wage deductions, for which I wish to thank you.

As stated in your letter of the 18th, I received my final salary from the N. S. McNeil Trading Co., Ltd., at the time I left, and also brought with me from my previous residence at 2292 East Hastings Street, Vancouver, what personal belongings I was allowed to carry, leaving behind nothing that I need to claim for now. I am in possession of the Victory Bonds and the War Savings Certificates referred to and so believe, aside from the bank account which I intend to transfer as soon as I am settled, I have nothing left behind on the coast.
