In accordance with the request contained in your letter of February 4th, 1946, we enclose herewith Custodian eneque in the sum of \$26.38, representing one half the proceeds from sale of the radio which was owned jointly by your brother kiyoshi and yourself.

Your file has been reviewed and the following is noted.

According to information supplied to this office you were the registered owner of a fishing vessel the "STANDUST", which was said through the Japanese Fishing Vessel Disposal Committee for the net sum of \$245.00, and this sum was paid to you on April 23nd, 1942.

The radio which you declared, was sold, as stated above, for the net sum of \$52.76, and one half of this sim was credited to your account with the Custodian and the other half to the account of your brother Riyoshi.

The \$5.00 War Savings Certificate which you surrendered to the Royal Canadian Sounted Police, was handed over by those to the Gustodian for safe keeping. It is now in our safety deposit want and will be available to you when required.

Frudential Insurance Company of America, your mother being the beneficiary. On January 5th, 1943, we wrote to the insurance company advising them that we had no further interest in your policy, at the same time giving them your address at that time so that they would be able to communicate directly with you regarding same.

So far as personal effects are concerned, you declared these were in your own possession, and we presume you either disposed of these or left them in charge of your mother, as we found none belonging to you much the chattels were removed from 221 Rest 5th Avenue, where you lived with your mother.

It would appear that we have accounted for all the property of every kind loft by you in the protected area which vested in the Gustodian, and
