GENERAL SUMMARY

Jutaro KANEKO, Deceased.

Jutaro KANEKO died at New Denver, B. C. on February 28, 1946. He is survived by his widow, Tobei, file No. 9756, and one son, Shigeharu, a minor.

The only assets declared by KANEKO were a few household effects and one \$5.00 War Savings Certificate in the name of his son. The chattels were disposed of by KANEKO prior to his evacuation and the War Savings Certificate was left in his possession.

Claims were filed against him as follows:

Ichiro NAKATSUKA.....	\$244.55
Komaya Company.....	5.56

These were admitted by KANEKO in his letter of June 10, 1944, but he advised us that he had no means of paying his debts. The creditors were advised accordingly.

A claim was filed by the Department of Labour, against the Estate of the deceased, for recovery of the sum of \$80.00 to cover the cost of the burial. They were advised by this office on April 12, 1946, that there were no funds available from which to pay their claim.
