In his declaration, he reported ownership of a \$50.00 Victory Bond in his own possession and stated that he had a bank account in the Bank of Montreal, Main & Hastings Street, Vancouver, with a credit balance of \$50.00. Neither of these assets came under the control of the Custodian.

Two radios were reported to the Custodian by the Royal Ganadian Mounted Police as having been surrendered by Hitoshi NEKODA. These were sold, as shown by the Specified Articles Memornadum, and the net proceeds of the sale, in the amount of \$94.55, is standing to his credit with this office.
