GENERAL SUMMARY

August 13, 1946.

Re: Robert MINEMOTO, Reg. No. 11584

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 8, 1942. He was evacuated on April 11, 1942.

In his declaration he reported a truck surrendered at Hastings Park, Vancouver. This truck was released to the Pacific Co-Op Assn., sold by them and the net proceeds of \$238.35 were credited to the account of this man. This amount was remitted to MINEMOTO on December 11, 1943, January 13, 1944, February 11, 1944 and March 11, 1944.

He reported eleven \$5.00 War Savings Certificates and a Victory Bond in his own possession. These did not come under the control of this office.
