GENERAL SUMMARY

File No. 1905

17th November, 1945

Re: ADACHI, Senkichi - Reg.No. 08508

The above Japanese when registering with this office declared three \$5.00 War Savings Certificates as being in his possession. These were not brought under control by the Custodian.


He also declared 500' of shiplap lumber which was supposed to have been left on the property of his father at Mission, B.C. He registered with the Custodian on April 8th and was evacuated on April 11th, 1942. On May 20, 1942 our representative, D. A. Smith, visited the property of the father but was unable to locate the lumber and the Japanese was informed of this on April 17th, 1944 and also through the B. C. Security Commission on April 21st, 1944.

The above Japanese when registering declared a debt of \$25.00 owing to Dr. H. W. Riggs. However, on January 17, 1944 he stated that the account was only \$21.00. As no funds were on hand to his credit at this office he was asked to remit sufficient funds to cover but in his undated letter received here on June 19th, 1944 he stated that he was in no position to pay at that time. Dr. Riggs was written on June 20th, 1944 informing him of the facts as known to this office and advised him to deal with ADACHI direct as this office was not taking any further action in the matter.

As nothing further can be accomplished on this file through administration, it can be closed.

Dear Sirs:

Thank you for your letter of January 7th.

I wish to inform you that my balance owing to Dr. Riggs at present is twenty-one dollars (\$21.00). The sum of \$25.00 on my file at your office is incorrect and I remember having it filed at \$25.00 which is a mistake on my part.

I have all receipts up to December of 1942 and on the reverse side of last receipt it has balance due \$21.00.

I have been sick from February of 1941 and still unfit for any work.

In regard to my 500 feet of ship-lap on Asa Adachi's farm on Cade Barr Road in Mission City, I wish to have it sold and the money paid to my doctor and I will pay the balance as soon as I am notified.
