GENERAL SUMMARY

This woman, in her declaration to the Custodian on March 23, 1942, declared a quantity of chattels. On October 15, 1942, Mr. J. D. Mather informed this office that Miss UCHIKURA had disposed of a small part of her furniture for \$78.00 which she had received direct, and that she was taking the remainder with her.

In her declaration she reported two \$50.00 Victory Bonds in her own possession. These did not come under the control of this office.

She declared a Japan & Canada Trust Savings Co. account, with \$307.65 on deposit, but as her name does not appear on the list of depositors as at December 31, 1942, it is assumed that the funds were withdrawn prior to that date.

The above owner carries on business as a dressmaker at the above address which is well located on the West side of Main St. near King Edward Avenue.

OWNERSHIP

The above named Uchikura is the sole owner of the business.

FINANCIAL POSITION

Apparently no liabilities. No insurance. Inventory not taken as owner wishes to continue carrying on business until moved by the Commission. She also states that, in the event of her being moved, she wishes to either store a part of the furniture and equipment or realize upon it herself. I would estimate that the business as it now stands would not realize at sale more than \$300.

RECOMMENDATION

I would recommend that the owner be permitted to carry on the business until moved by the Commission.
