
Re: Yutaka OGAWA - Reg. No. 13109

On May 14th an enquiry was sent to this office regarding a credit note towards the purchase of an automobile from Campbell Motors Limited in Vancouver.

This office has several such credit notes, and has spent considerable time on correspondence and advertising in an effort to dispose of these. Because of the shortage of used cars and the impossibility of obtaining new cars it has been impossible to interest anyone in purchasing these credits even at a discount.

These credit notes have been upheld in court, and are of value only as a credit in the purchase of an automobile from the company issuing.

We regret, therefore, that no further action can be taken at this time.
