HISTORY OF ADMINISTRATION: This property was left by Mrs. Go in the care of T.A. Pelton of Whonnock, to whom the key of the house was given, and whose daughter, Mrs. J.S. Hewison, informed the Custodian on 19th June 1942 that Mrs. Go had agreed that she, Mrs. Hewison, would be allowed to occupy until Mrs. Go's return. This statement was confirmed by Mrs. Go in a letter dated 30th June 1942. On 12th October 1942, Mrs. Hewison advised the Custodian that, having bought a farm, she was moving to it, leaving a friend on the Go property to take care of it. On 3rd December 1942, Mrs. Hewison wrote that this friend had vacated the premises and that the keys had been returned to Mr. Pelton.

The house was rented by the Custodian to J.M. Williams for one month - July 14th to August 14th 1943, at a rental of \$7.00, and to E.L. Ball from January 11th to February 29th, 1944, for repairs, and from March 1st to 30th June 1944 for \$20.00.
