


REFUNDS:


The following claims were filed with the Custodian and acknowledged by Takejira MITANI.

These claims remain unpaid, *and the creditor advised that the Custodian has no funds belonging to MITANI.*

In addition the Maple Ridge Co-operative Produce Exchange filed a claim of \$93.93 against Takejira MITANI on November 30th, 1942, on which they held a note of \$79.75. This latter amount was acknowledged as correct by MITANI who in his letter of February 13th, 1943 stated that as he held 111 shares in the Maple Ridge Co-operative Exchange he would not have to pay this debt. Subsequently the Maple Ridge Co-operative Exchange under authority of the Custodian cancelled 94 shares of his holding to pay off the liability of \$93.93, leaving a balance of .07 to MITANI's credit.

Dear sir

In regard to the claims lodged against me with the custodian, I disagree with two of the claims listed. First I have no debt of \$93.93 owing to the Maple Ridge Co-op produce. The note of \$79.75 is correct and I handed the note to Mr. G. Yamaga, manager of the Coop on March 11, 1942. The other, the \$26.00 owing to Mr. G. Yamaga, I know is only \$16.00. I handed a note to Mr. G. Yamaga on March 11, 1942 for that also. I have a share of \$111 at the Maple Ridge co-op and therefore would not have to make any of these payments. The other claims, however, to the Royal Columbian hospital & to M. Dishing & Co Ltd. I find are correct. I regret to add that at present, I am unable to settle any of these accounts, and could

not promise when I will be able to settle
the accounts.

Gentlemen :-

Re: Takajiro Mitani

Replying to your letter of the 12th inst.
regarding the above noted account.

Our list of Japanese Accounts receivable
of April 30, 1942 included the name of T. Mitani show-
ing a balance of \$93.93, Note \$79.75. This was meant
to indicate that of the amount \$93.93 we held his note
for \$79.75. It was not meant to infer that we held
a note for an additional \$79.75.

Regarding his note in favour of Y. Yamaga.
We hold one for \$27.43 which is dated Apl. 11, 1941.
That has nothing to do with us. It is a private matter
with Yamaga.

Apparently Mitani considers that account
paid when he gave a note. His claim to having 111 shares
is correct, but we have not authority to cancel shares
for debt. Almost all balances owing by Japanese could
be cleared by the cancellation of shares owned. The
Co-operative Associations Act empowers us to do so;
but an order, dated Sept. 4, 1942, from the Custodian,
directed that we should not make any change in the Cap-
ital set-up without his permission. We have sought
permission on two occasions without success. If we
could do so it would be to our mutual benefit.
