The above, who made his declaration to the Custodian on April 8/42 and was evacuated on May 21/42, declared household effects at 1332 Seymour St. and store supplies and fixtures at 743 Pacific St.

We appointed Mr. W.H. Watson to investigate and on April 23/42 a report was received from him. In our letter to Mr. Watson dated April 30/42 we advised him that NISHIZAWA should proceed to find a purchaser for his business.

No further report appears on file and we must assume that NISHIZAWA disposed of everything prior to evacuation. However we had Mr. Wills call at the two mentioned addresses and give us a report. The following is his report:

743 Pacific St. Mr. Wills met the present owner, Mr. James A. Robson, who stated that he had purchased everything from NISHIZAWA on May 9/42 and held the receipt. A Mr. G.H. Grant on Aobson St. negotiated the deal for both parties.

1332 Seymour St. Mrs. Bondevud, the present tenant, states that she purchased the effects, and that she holds receipts for payments of same as follows:

Sept. 7/44 \$200.00 Sept. 9/44 \$23.00

She purchased them from a Mr. Frank Wurz, who was probably the original purchaser from NISHIZAWA.

Your Investigator desires to draw your attention to the service rendered by a Japanese Salvation Army Officer, M. Yamada. Considerable difficulty was experienced on two visits to the premises, Mishizawa, who does not speak English, being confined to bed at home, and his wife, Mateu, displaying heatility and refusing definitely to answer any questions. On the third visit Nishizawa was prosent but it was only by the sensible and kindly cooperation of Yamada that friendly relations were established and the foregoing information obtained. transpired that the enspicion and hostility shown proviously was due to the fact that Nichtman is mituralized and that his regis-tration card No. 00066 is imprinted by the R.C.M.P. What required to register as an enemy alters and enquiries on the part of the Custodian were regarded as an intrusion.
