The precedure entails obtaining independent appraisals and calling for benders by public adunder the Chairmannity of Judge Thittenide, and if the offers are equivalent to or exceed the valuations, the Countities that recommends acceptance and all donements are sent to Ottom for signature of the Socretary of State. possible to liquidate these Setute parcels by taking advantage of Section 4 of P.C. 2483, dated the 27th of March, 1942, in part as follows: "(2) The Custodian may, notwithstanding enything contained in this Regulation, order that all or any property mateograp, situated in any protected area of British Columbia, belonging to any person of the Japanese race shall, for the purpose of protecting the interests of the owner or any other person, be vested in the Custodian, and the Gustodian shall have full power to administer such proporty for the benefit of all such interested persons, and shall release such proporty upon being satisfied that the interests aforesaid will not be projudiced (3) For the purposes of the control and management of such property by the Consolidated Regulations Respecting Trading With The Recent (1939). shall apply metatic matendic to the same extent as if the property belonged to an enemy within the meaning of the said Consolidated Regulations". Section 23 of the Revised Regulations Respecting Frading With The Ereny (1943) provides as follows: *(1) Where any real estate or interest therein is vested in the Gustodian he may insue a cortificate stating that such real estate or interest therein is vested in the Oustolian and such certificate shall be registered without charge in the Land Titles Office or registration office in the district in which the real estate is situate, but failure to register such a cortificate shall not release the real estate or interest thereis from the provisions of these Regulations, (2) After the registration of such certificate and upon the written request of the Quetodian, the proper officer in the Land Titles Office or registration office in the district in which the real estate is situate shall, whore there is provision for transfer of titles, forthwith and mithout charge transfer the title of the real estate or interest therein affected by the Custodien's cortificate into the name of "the Sodretary of State of Canada acting in his capacity as Custodian under the Revised Regulations Respecting Trading with the Snewy (1943)", without any transmission or other application or further proceeding. Herewith you will find the form of Order that we would send to Ottawn provided Mr. Streight approves this procedure. It appears that this would overcome many of the obstacles that stand in the way of liquidation by the Official Administrator, including the application for an order to cancel the Certificate of Title, The title would be transmitted into The Secretary of State and if cale was effected the proceeds would be paid to the Official Administrator for distribution to those entitled. We are sending a copy of this letter to Mr. Streight and would be glad if you would discuss the matter with him as soon as possible. Mr. Shears and the writer plan to attend a meeting of the Advisory Committee at New Westminster next Friday afternoon. We would be glad to meet Mr. Streight and yourself some time during the morning and if convenient, will arrange to be in Mr. Streight's office at 11 a.m. Thanking you in anticipation of your co-operation, we remain, Yours truly.
