File 20, 1940 761 June 1917 The above Japanese registered with the Custodies on the 7th April, 1942 and was evacuated on the 25th April, 1942. He declared so senete endoyt for a far Sardige Cartificate and a Manager Life Insurance policy, smither of which Close Disoughts ander group of by the surfaction. On checking the property of K. KATO, however, a few hopsehold chattels were found belonging to him. These were inventorised and a list formanded to SHIBLER. On the 5th Agreeber, 1982, SHIKER, admostedged they belonged to him and that the list was correct. The chattels were left in the sere of the tenant on KATO's property. An offer of \$2.00 was made by the tenant to purchase his dramar. This was accepted in his letter of the 3rd January, 1983, and this amount was credited to his account on the 3let March, 1983. In January, 1945, our fieldmen inspected the chattels remaining on LATO's premises to liquidate the chattels. Part were removed to auction where they were sold for the net sum of \$5.26, and part were sold by appraisal of \$6.00. Both these amounts were credited to SHILLZE's account as received. The chattels were well accounted so, although the store, a table, bed and some chairs were abundanced as not being worth the expense of handling. MACHINA DESIGNATION OF THE PARTY OF THE PART

When registering with the Sustodian SHIKAZE declared owing his cousin M. KARIATSUMARE, the sum of \$200.00. The Mission Memorial Respital also filed a claim for \$7.20. Both were admostledged correct on the 12th Schober, 1942, although he stated he had no funds to make settlement.

The funds accruing to SHIKARE's aredit at this office amounted to \$13.26 this was use paid to KARIATSUMARI's account as partial payment on the 13th May, 1947, and both were advised they would have to look to SHIKAZE direct for the belance.

This file reveals no other assets or liabilities and requires no further administration.

The above summary is certified to be in accordance with the information on file.
