
When reporting on chattels June 28/44, we had opened the basement door of 1011 Royal Ave. with the key supplied by tenants of the house. The furniture seemed jammed close to this door and undisturbed. Upon removing the effects later however, it was found that entry had been obtained by someone, on the other side of the basement where a door was open, and from all appearances some things had been removed and tampered with. In any event one room was empty and the other with the locked door and adjoining was half empty. The tenants stated that plumbers had been working in the basement a year or so ago.

The records in connection with chattels at these places are very unsatisfactory, Nishijimi, the landlord (File 11662) and Nishi the tenant, are both vague in their declarations. The latter, on file 1838, declares sewing machines, etc. but gives no definite answer to our letter of Nov. 24/42, in which we ask whether these or any other effects had been shipped to them, and other particulars.

There were no effects at 1010 Quebec St., the tenant stating that they were taken away by the owners of the house.

Some of these effects may belong to Shizuko Baba, File 7827. Mrs. Baba declares she left some things there.
