



PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

RE: Daimatsu YOSHINAKA, Reg. No. 07384

This file reveals that YOSHINAKA owned no real property in any protected area of B. C. and did not carry any Fire Insurance.

CHATELS: YOSHINAKA made his declaration to the Custodian on March 28/42 and was evacuated on March 29/42. He declared a long list of chattels at 434 W. 2nd Ave. We advised him on Nov. 10/43 that our representatives had called at this address but had been advised by the tenant that YOSHINAKA had either sold his chattels or taken them with him. We told him we therefore assumed he had no personal property remaining in the protected area of B.C. He signed our copy of this letter confirming that this was correct.

However on list of goods belonging to different Japanese left at the B.C.Purchasers supplied to us by Norris & MacLennan, 2 beds belonging to Daimatsu YOSHINAKA are listed. Two beds from the B.C.Purchasers were sold in his name for the net sum of \$8.79 and this sum credited to his account with the Custodian.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.


