Dear Sirs:

I am approaching you for a little assistance in connection with some household goods, the property of Senzo TSUCHIYA, #00567, at 2229 Triumph Street, Vancouver, and hope that you will be able to let me have some information which I can pass on to Tsuchiya.

On looking over the file, I find that a report from our Mr. C. W. Fisher, in charge of transportation, advises that this place (2229 Triumph Street, Vancouver,) was broken into and all the boxes and cartons were opened. A later report from Mr. Fisher indicates that there is nothing left at this address of sufficient value to ship. Tsuchiya is of the opinion that while what is left may not appear to be of value to ship, it may be of use and of some value to him and it would be appreciated, if it is not too much trouble, if you could send me a list of what goods remain at this address.

Tsuchiya is a maintenance case and is not, therefore, able to accept much expense towards the packing and shipping of these goods but he is prepared to do a little scrimping and pay up to \$3.00 to offset any necessary packing charges, providing he knows what is left in the building.

Our Mr. Fisher advises that the goods were covered by burglar insurance but Tsuchiya has no recollection of such insurance being taken out to cover. Would you possibly know anything about this insurance?

Thank you in advance for anything you can do in this connection and awaiting reply at your convenience.
