I, Hiyoshi Ueyuzi, reg no 11385, am writing to you about our personal articles stored in the basement of my mother in law's house, Mrs. Chie Nagai, 4160 Union St. and the house is now occupied by Mrs. Marion Parken.

I must move to the east in the near future so I would like to have the following articles sent to us. 1 complete bed, vanity and mirror, 4 chairs, 1 paper box of articles, few remaining things which had to be removed from the box I had sent her before, and 3 rolls of carpet.

There is also 1 stove, 1 oil heater and 2 side tables but I do not need these right now.

Having the things sent to us will no doubt amount to quite a some in freight and I would appreciate it if you could take part of the payment out of the bill of which we had to pay when leaving Ocean Falls. At the time when the Commission was refunding the money for fare, freight refund was not done till later and so I did not receive this refund, only the fare refund was paid to us.

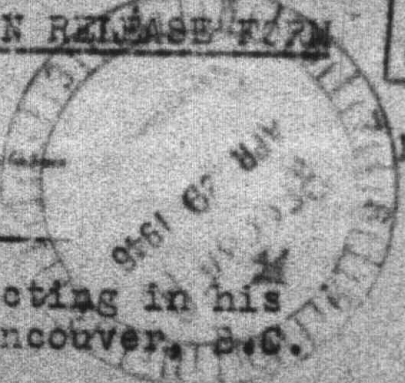
