Regarding the first named, I am enclosing herewith, statement in duplicate of the household effects and other properties claimed by this man, but as you will see on this statement, the Island on which his assets were found, is registered in the name of another party, and naturally, although this man claims ownership of the buildings, they would belong to the owner of the property. ✓

The personal effects which we have taken away and stored in the central building where all the Japanese goods are now held, are in very bad condition and have very little value. However, they are all now tagged with his name and safely stored away.

Re Y. Yoshida, giving former address of 1140 Stewart Avenue. I have no information regarding this party, but have a declaration from Mrs. Hamanishi, residing at that address, but, who in her declaration makes claim to all goods found in this premises.

In consideration of this, I would require more information regarding this party if you wish a further report.



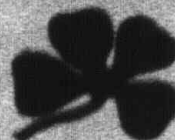


