Re: Katsutaro TSUBOI, Registration No. 08732

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 10, 1942. He was evacuated on September 19, 1942.

In his declaration he reported a trunk and clothes bag left at Stillwater, B.C. Owing to the difficulty of getting to Stillwater all goods were left there. This appears on our "Stillwater missing chattel" file.

In a letter written on July 21, 1942 Mr. Spain reports that this man has a debt owing to him by M. Ebisuzaki Co. for wages. We referred this claim to P. S. Ross and Sons but to date no settlement has been received.

This file reveals no other property of any kind.


