He has requested us to sell his set of 12 Encyclopaedia and text books.

This file shows no record of the removal of these books from 4337 Parker St.

It is probable that these books were moved in the name of his father, Asakichi KAWANAMI, File No. 10216. Inventory No. 367 mentions 10 boxes and it is possible the books are contained in some of these boxes.

Mr. Masao KAWANAMI wishes the books sold and the proceeds paid to him as he expects to receive orders to proceed overseas to the Orient at any time.
