





The above, who made his declaration to the Custodian on March 27/42 and was evacuated on March 29/42, declared the following:

- 1 Trunk of clothing stored at 117 Main St., Vancouver
- 1 Stove
- 4 Chairs
- 2 Tables
- 1 Bed

1 Set of kitchen utensils, all stored at 660 Alexander St., Van.

At his request, his trunk and contents were shipped to him by the B.C.S.C. on May 25/44.

As there is no such number as 660 Alexander St., we could not find chattels declared by the above. We wrote to him on Oct. 27/42 and advised him of this fact. He replied on Nov. 20/42 stating that he had not sold or disposed of his chattels, but advised us that his landlady, Mrs. Sayono MATSUNO, Main Rooms, 117 Main St., was taking care of them for him. He stated that he had not heard from her since his evacuation and asked us to get in touch with her and find out what she had done with the chattels. On Jan. 6/43, we wrote to YAMAMOTO and advised him that we could not find his chattels and that we had no one registered under the name of Mrs. Sayono MATSUNO, and asked him if he was sure he had given us the name correctly. He has not written or given us any further information on the matter of his chattels, so we presume that he has thought them of insufficient value to bother any more about, or he has been advised by Mrs. MATSUNO of their disposal.

We advised YAMAMOTO on Jan. 12/44 that we were unable to locate T. FUJI and A. SUMI, and asked him to give us more information on all the accounts so that we might collect them for him. We received no reply to this letter. On Jan. 31/44 we wrote and advised him that we had heard from the wife of G. MORITA who stated that they had no account outstanding owing to YAMAMOTO. On March 10/45 we advised him that we had heard from J. ENOUE who stated that he had paid YAMAMOTO the sum of \$140.00 prior to their evacuation from the Coast. He was given the address of both MORITA AND ENOUE in case he wished to contact them direct regarding these accounts. The other three we have been unable to contact. Nothing further has been heard from YAMAMOTO with



regard to these accounts so it is possible he has settled them direct with the debtors.
