LIFE INSURANCE:

On April 10, 1942, the above named declared he had in his possession a Sun Life Assurance Company policy in the amount of \$1,000.00 - Beneficiary, mother, Kiya. Mr. HAYASHIDA requested the cash surrender value of the Sun Life Assurance Company policy but owing to the beneficiary - his mother - living in Japan it was necessary for the Custodian to sign the application of release. On HAYASHIDA's request, this was completed by the Custodian and the amount of the cash surrender of the Policy being \$248.24 less the automatic premium loan of \$94.50 - a net amount of \$153.74 was credited to HAYASHIDA's account with the Custodian and forwarded direct to him on March 15, 1943.
