

Re: CHATTELS

Chattels (as per copy of Inventory No. 342 attached) were moved from 325 W. 4th Avenue to central storage at 604 E. Cordova Street.

The tenant, Mr. Delaire, was leaving and a Chinese tenant moving in, so Mr. Delaire said he would be unable to accept the responsibility for the chattels.

The property of several Japanese was stored here and as correct ownership could not be established by identification marks, it becomes necessary to put this inventory on all files concerned.

In this building, there is a suite between #15 and #16 without a number. It was locked, and we were obliged to force the lock. The suite was found to contain furniture and personal effects crowded to the ceiling and all walls. There was so much stored here that it would probably take three days trucking to remove it to storage, and under the circumstances the suite was secured by lock and allowed to remain undisturbed pending further developments.

In the lower suite nothing was left in a packed condition; everything had apparently been pushed into this place and left without any effort to mark or separate ownership.
