In reply to your letter of the 25th instant, will you kindly note that the caretaker of the Gorge Park, Mr. Stancil, Tillicum Road, Esquimalt states that this Japanese told him that he intended to leave one trunk containing Japanese kimono in his custody but that the above Japanese later changed his mind.

As regards the hope chest containing silver, my representative informs me that prior to evacuation this chest was mentioned to him by Takata and he was informed that this chest was to be left behind.

In the subsequent inventory taken no mention of this is made but as there are boxes with contents unknown will you be so kind as to ascertain from this Japanese the description of the box said to contain this silver and the exact room in which he claims to have left it. On receipt of this information I shall be glad to submit a further report.
